Dear Judge,

The Irish Kennel Club recognises the Breed Standards of national kennel club's native breeds, which are in turn accepted by the F.C.I.

However, you may or may not be aware that standards issued by some Kennel Clubs differ from those issued by the native kennel authority and consequently from those accepted by the F.C.I. This causes a problem for both judges and exhibitors. This is particularly relevant to breeds of Irish origin and as the guardians of these standards is an area the Irish Kennel Club takes very seriously.

To address this, we ask that you make yourself familiar with the breed standard as set down by the breeds native kennel club and as accepted by the F.C.I. We also request that you acknowledge your agreement to this by signing the declaration below.
