## SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS TO EXHIBITORS

1. The Show will be held under the rules of the Irish Kennel Club and a copy of the Rules will be posted in the office of the Secretary on the day of the Show. A 'Dog' in the following rules shall be deemed to mean both sexes.
2. **Date:** The Show will be held on Wednesday 17th March, 2010 at the National Show Centre, Cloghran, Co. Dublin. **Judging will commence at 8.30a.m for Junior Handling Classes. Breed Judging in all rings will commence at 9.00a.m.**
3. **ENTRY FEES:** The entry fee will be €20.00 first dog, second dog €10. **Puppy Stakes - €5.00 Pet Plan Junior Stakes - €5.00, Champion Stakes - €5.00, Junior Handling Classes – free if the dog is entered in the breed, otherwise €5.00. Agility & Obedience - €12.00 first dog, second dog €6, additional classes €6 per dog**

**ENTERING EXHIBITS:** Entries will be received up to and including Friday, 22nd January 2010 (postmark). On line entries will be accepted until midnight on Monday 1st February 2010. Entries must be made on the form issued for this purpose. Entry forms must be completed in ink. Details of entries and fees to be sent to **The Show Secretary, The Irish Kennel Club, Fottrell House, Harold's Cross Bridge, Dublin 6W.** If you wish to enter for the Show on line please log on to [www.ikc.ie](http://www.ikc.ie) for further information and to download an entry form.

**ENTRY FORMS:** The Catalogue will be compiled from the Entry Forms submitted by Exhibitors, and the Irish Kennel Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes therein.

**EXHIBITORS SHALL BE ENTITLED TO FREE PASSES TO THE SHOW:** i.e. 1 free pass for 1 or 2 dogs; 2 free passes for 3 or 4 dogs and so on.

4. **REJECTING ENTRIES:** etc.: The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the Catalogue or the allocation of Stand Space at the Show.

**INELIGIBLE ENTRIES:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging, but in no other respects.

5. **REGISTRATIONS:** All Dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club or other FCI Kennel Club. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
6. **PRIZE CARDS** will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Reserve in each Class. Rosettes will be given to Green Star winners, Best of Breed, Group winners & Reserve Group winners, to 4<sup>th</sup> place. Best in Show, Reserve Best in Show, to 4<sup>th</sup> place. Best Junior in Breed, Puppy Stakes 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place. Champion Stakes 1 – 4<sup>th</sup> place.
7. **PRIZES WITHHELD:** A Judge shall be empowered to withhold any prize, prizes or Green Stars if in his (or her) opinion, the exhibits are not of sufficient merit.

8. **WHERE SPECIAL PRIZES** are offered for competition by or through a Specialist Club, they are responsible for the collection and distribution same.
9. **EXHIBITS NOT SENT:** Persons entering an exhibit or exhibits and failing to send them for exhibition or should their exhibit or exhibits be rejected by one of the Veterinary Surgeons, will forfeit the entrance fees paid in respect of such exhibit or exhibits.

The Irish Kennel Club cannot accept any responsibility for the absence of any dog when the judging of a Breed or Class or Group is about to commence.

10. **VETERINARY EXAMINATION:** Any Veterinary Surgeon acting with the Authority of the Show Committee may have any dog removed from the Show on any of the following grounds: (i) suspected cause of infection or contagious disease (ii) totally blind or deaf (iii) castrated (iv) vicious or savage disposition. If requested by the Show Secretary, the Veterinary Surgeon shall give such order in writing, together with the reason for it.
11. **ADMISSION CHARGES:** Car Parking €5.00. All admissions €5. Car + all passengers €20. Family ticket which includes Car Park: €20.00. **Associate Members of the Irish Kennel Club admitted free upon production of current Membership Card. Car Park fee €5.00**
12. **CAR PARK:** €5.00 per car. This may be prepaid.
13. **STANDS:** Sales of any article will only be permitted to take place from a duly licensed stand.
14. **CATALOGUES:** will be on sale within the Showgrounds. Price €5.00 each. This may be prepaid.
15. **CLOSING OF THE SHOW:**  
All exhibits must be removed by the person in charge, or by their owners not later than half an hour after completion of the Judging of Best in Show.
16. **JUDGES:** If circumstances arise to prevent any judge selected from keeping his or her engagement, the Committee reserves the right to employ another judge. The right is reserved to the Show Committee or to the Chairman of the Irish Kennel Club to change a judge in a breed or breeds, or part of a breed if it is considered such a change is in the best interests of the Show.
17. **JUDGING:** (a) Will commence at 8.30a.m Junior Handling Classes. Breed Judging in all rings will commence at 9.00a.m. (b) No person will be allowed in Judging Ring, except the Judge, Show Official or any exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication. (c) Exhibitors will not be allowed to wear a badge or other decoration in the Breed Judging Ring save the exhibition number of each dog which must be clearly displayed by the exhibitor. (d) The following officials of the Show will not be permitted to exhibit thereat. viz: a Judge, a Veterinary Surgeon, a Steward (except when acting as such and in the execution of his duties) the Show Committee, the Secretary or any member of the Irish Kennel Club Staff.
18. **JUDGE'S DECISION:** The decision of a Judge at the termination of his or her judging a Class shall be final, except in the case of an objection properly made and upheld under the Rules of the Irish Kennel Club or where a Judge states that a

- clerical or other mistake was made in the award as officially returned, or on the grounds of fraud.
19. **PROTEST:** All protests must be made in the manner specified in Irish Kennel-Club Rules.
  20. **RESPONSIBILITY:**
    - (a) The Irish Kennel Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained by an exhibitor through accident or otherwise.
    - (b) The Irish Kennel Club will not be responsible for any accident, that may occur to any exhibitor or other person attending the Show.
    - (c) Visitors are requested not to handle the dogs sent for exhibition.
    - (d) Dogs will not be permitted in the Bar or Refreshment Rooms.
  21. **ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS** appearing in any daily newspaper or other publication in reference to any alterations made by the Show Committee in the Schedule or in these regulations, shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
  22. **IN CONNECTION WITH THE SHOW:**
    - (a) The General Purposes Committee of the Irish Kennel Club shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the Rules, and all disputes arising shall be dealt with by this Committee in accordance with the powers delegated to it by the Council.
    - (b) Should any dispute arise for which a specific rule is not provided such matter in dispute shall be referred to the General Purposes Committee for decision. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Council of the Irish Kennel Club. The Chairman of the Irish Kennel Club Show Committee shall be given Executive Powers to decide any point arising at the Show.
    - (c) During the exhibition of Dogs at this show the officiating Judge will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ring-siders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.
  23. **FOULING:** A minimum fine of €0.00 shall be imposed on any exhibitor who fails to clean up fouling by their dogs in the precincts of the show.
  24. **ALL DOGS** competing must be on a lead, unless when under a judge.

## **RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW**

1. The Irish Kennel Club will not accept any responsibility nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups, or for Best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The Irish Kennel Club will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, owing to the judging of its breed not having been completed, or for any other reason.
2. Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners in their breed
3. No dog shall be entitled to compete in a Group where any prize or award has been withheld from it in its breed at the show.
4. A fee will not be payable for entry in any of the Groups nor for Best in Show.
5. Groups will be divided into ten sections - as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules & Regulations.
6. Upon entering the Group Ring Competitors must produce their correct ring number.
7. In each Group and Best in Show the judges shall make the following awards: viz, 1st, 2nd, 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> place, absentees MUST be marked.
8. Competition for Best in Show and Reserve Best In Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups.
9. If the Group Judging has not commenced before 4:30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €50 and be disqualified from all wins on the day unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before judging commences.

### **SECTION 1 – RULE 7 – REGISTRATION**

Every dog exhibiting or competing at any Show, Field Trial or obedience Test, must be registered with the Irish Kennel Club or other FCI kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor or competitor, save in the case of Greyhounds duly registered with the Irish Coursing Club and dog not of a recognised breed for which licences have been approved for Obedience, Agility or Working Tests.

Failure to comply with the above will result in (a) the dog being disqualified from the event and (b) the exhibitor being fined €27 – the implementation of which shall be a normal office routine. All appeals to the Irish Kennel Club should carry a fee of €6, refundable if the appeal is upheld.

### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

It is an Irish Kennel Club regulation that permission must be sought from the Show promoting body for the use of cameras or other recording equipment. Permission must also be obtained from the judge in the ring of the day. (Subject to Regulation 17 paragraph (b) page 3)

## **CLASSIFICATION FOR ALL BREEDS**

**Two Green Stars for all breeds – “Celtic Junior Winner 2010” & “Celtic Winner 2010” titles available for all breeds**

**Dogs: Puppy - Junior - Intermediate - Open - Champion - Veteran - Field Trial  
Bitches Puppy - Junior - Intermediate - Open - Champion - Veteran - Field Trial**

### **CLASS DEFINITIONS**

(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

**A Puppy Class** is confined to dogs over six and under twelve months of age on the day of the Show.

**A Junior Class** is for dogs between nine and eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show computed from and inclusive of the date of its birth.

**An Intermediate Class** is for dogs between 15 and 24 calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

**Open Class** is for dogs over 15 months of age on the day of the Show.

**Champions Class** is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under the rules and regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

**Veteran Class** is for dogs over eight years of age on the day of the Show **\*\* Please note – a Veteran Dog who is also a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.\*\***

**Field Trial Class** is confined to dogs who have won at least a reserve in a Puppy, Novice, Derby or Open Stake as defined in the Field Trial Rules & Regulations.

**Puppy Stakes Dogs 6 – 12 months & Puppy Stakes Bitches 6 – 12 months**, four dogs and four bitches will be selected by the judge to compete for Best Puppy.

**Pet Plan Junior Stakes Dogs (6 to 18 months) & Pet Plan Junior Stakes Bitches (6 to 18 months)**

1. Separate Dog and Bitch "qualifying" classes will be held, and the Petplan Junior Stakes "Final" will be held during the afternoon.  
One dog and one bitch to qualify from each class, which will give a total of two in the "Final"  
One overall winning dog or bitch will then be chosen as the "Petplan Junior Winner"
2. Placing in the two qualifying classes as follows:-  
1st, 2nd, 3rd, Reserve, VHC. With prize money as follows:- 1st €30, 2nd €25. 3rd €20. Reserve €15. and VHC €10. Rosettes will be given out for all placing.  
Placing in the "Final" 1st and 2nd with prize money as follows. 1st €200 and a trophy, 2nd €75. Rosettes to be given to both winner and runner-up.

**Champion Stakes** is for dogs who have gained the title of Champion under Irish Kennel Club rules or under another recognised Kennel Authority confirmed by the date of closing of entries.

All exhibits entered in stake classes must be entered in their relevant breed class with the exception of Veteran

**The decisive date in respect of age is the day the dog is shown.**

**OBEDIENCE CLASS DEFINITIONS**

**Beginners** Confined to dogs and handlers which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any Obedience test or (b) 3 or more First prizes in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Rules or (c) under any Kennel Club recognised by The Irish Kennel Club.

**Novice** Confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test or (b) 4 or more First prizes in any obedience test except Beginners.

**Graduate** Confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test or (b) 4 or more First prizes in any obedience test except Beginners and/or Novice.

**Limit** Confined to dogs which have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test or (b) 4 First prizes in any obedience test except Beginners and/or Novice and/or Graduate.

**Open** Open to all.

**AGILITY CLASS DEFINITIONS**

**Grade 1** For owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. *N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class*

**Grade 2** For owners, handlers or dogs which have qualified out of Grade 1 but have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. *N.B. Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1, (Elementary) are not eligible for this class.*

**Grade 3** Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7.

**Grade 4** Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7.

**Grade 5** Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7.

**Grade 6** Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 5 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5 or 7.

**Grade 7** Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 6 at Irish Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows. Two first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

- Group 1:** 10 - 12 Years of age (i.e. to the 13th Birthday)  
**Group 2:** 13 - 14 Years of age (i.e. to the 15th Birthday)  
**Group 3:** 15 - 17 Years of age (i.e. to the 18th Birthday)  
**(A declaration is required from the parent or guardian of each handler in relation to the child's age.)**
