

ABRIDGED RULES GOVERNING REGISTRATION

(ISSUED APRIL 2013)

1. The Declaration on each application for registration must be signed by the breeder, this signature to be considered as endorsement of its correctness. In certain cases, where the signature of the breeder cannot be procured, the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., may, upon proper application, waive this requirement, subject to the production of such evidence as it may require.
2. As the duplication of names is not permitted, you are requested to state your first, second and third choice. The Irish Kennel Club Ltd. reserves the right to alter a letter or word in the name applied for in case of duplication, likely confusion or other reason thought fit.
3. Not more than two dogs may be registered with the same prefix/affix by the breeder, or from the same litter. Should it be desired to use the word on three or more occasions it will be required to be registered as a prefix/affix.
4. No change or addition of any sort will be permitted in the registered name of a dog, except by the addition of a registered prefix/affix.
5. An application for registration, when lodged, becomes the property of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd., but a copy of the application may be obtained at any time by the registered owner upon payment of the appropriate fee.
6. (a) All dogs whelped within the jurisdiction of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. must be registered by the Breeder.
(b) Applications for registration shall be made on the form prescribed, duly signed by the breeder.
(c) The breeder is the registered owner or registered lessee of the dam at the date of whelping.
7. (a) Registration of dogs, litters, kennel names, owners, transfers, pedigrees, etc., shall be subject to such documented information being furnished as the Secretary of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. may consider necessary in the particular case in addition to the name and address of the owner, breeder, and owner of Sire, colour and markings and date of birth.
(b) The Irish Kennel Club Ltd. may require any dog to be certified as being suitable for registration.
8. All services of the Irish Kennel Club are confined to Associate Members only.
9. From 1st January 2011 The Irish Kennel Club will not accept individual applications for registration/transfer from minors under the age of 16 years.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Registration is confined to

- (a) Dogs whelped in Ireland whose parents are registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd.
- (b) Dogs whelped in Ireland where the dam is registered with the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. and the sire is registered with another recognised Kennel Authority.
- (c) Dogs whelped outside the jurisdiction of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. if registered with a recognised Kennel Authority Form OS1 required.
- (d) Extraneous applications, e.g. not covered in (a). (b) or (c) above, must be considered for approval by the General Purposes Committee
