Dear Exhibitor,

Please be advised your Ring Numbers will be given to you by the Ring Steward on the Day of the Show.
We wish to draw your attention to the following points.

Judging Commences at 9.30am in all Rings

1. POST COVID PROTOCOLS.

It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to familiarise themselves with the IKC Best Practice Guidelines for post Covid Shows in Ireland and adhere to same. Masks must be worn in Show Ring & Indoor Facilities.

****Please ensure to have your Contact Tracing Form completed to hand in at the entrance to the Show****

2. ARRIVAL AT SHOW

Dogs will be received at the show grounds from 8.00 a.m. Exhibitors arriving after 8.00 a.m. do so at their own risk.

3. CATALOGUES

Catalogues – Available on-line and a limited number will be available for €5.00 each at the Show. Pre-paid catalogues must be collected from the Secretary's Office before 2 p.m.

4. Please remember this is an outdoor Show so please wear appropriate clothing.

4. BEST OF BREED AND GROUP JUDGING

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be present at the Ring at the commencement of the Judging of Best of Breed and the Groups. Any late arrival will be excluded from the Judging Ring. The assembly point for all Group and Best in Show will be the Parade Ring in Navan Racecourse.

5. COLLECTION OF ROSETTES

Exhibitors are advised to collect their Best of Breed rosettes at the Secretary's Office at earliest possible opportunity. Rosettes will be issued on production of the appropriate card.

6. CATERING

Catering facilities will be available. Dogs are not allowed in the Dining Areas. **Please ensure to have your Covid Vaccination Certificate** with you if you wish to avail of Restaurant or Bar areas.

7. Exhibitors or others handling dogs are warned that a fine of €50.00 will be imposed in the event of Dogs fouling at the venue. It is pointed out that fouling in the vicinity of the Show also falls into this category. In order to minimise fouling it is expected that every care will be taken to exercise dogs before entering the Show Area or its vicinity.

8. SECURITY:

Security will patrol the grounds during the Show. However, please lock your cars and do not leave valuables on view. Yours dogs and your possessions are your responsibility and should not be left unattended at any time.
